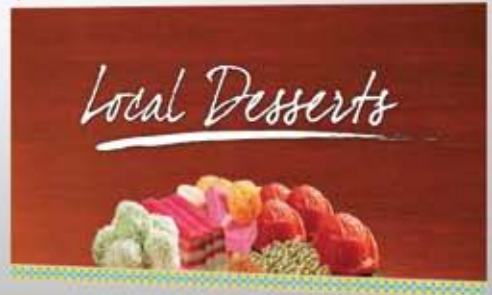

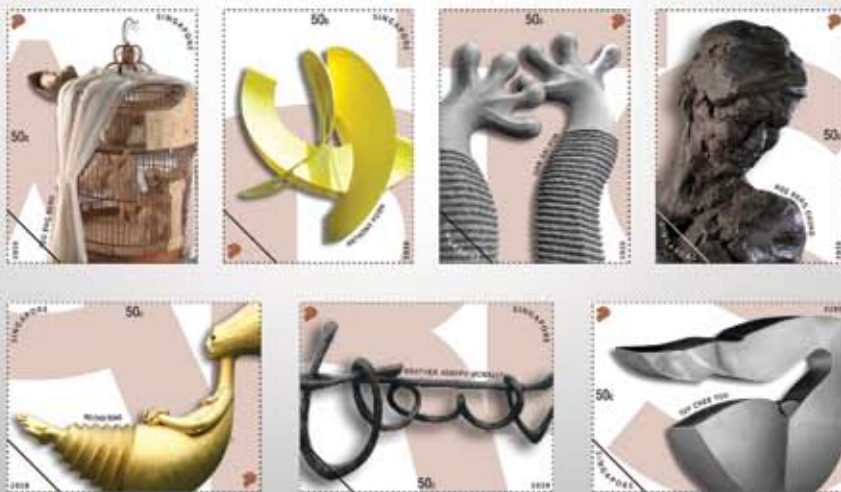

# Singapore 2010 Youth Olympic Games

Date of Issue:

**14 Aug 2009**

The Singapore 2010 Youth Olympic Games is just 365 days away – with the spirit of vibrant energy going stronger everyday. To commemorate the one-year countdown event on 14 Aug 2009, this series of Singapore Youth Olympic Games commemorative stamps will be launched. The commemorative stamps have been created in celebration of the city's progress and oneness towards inspiring youth to embrace, embody and express the Olympic values of Excellence, Friendship and Respect in all spheres of life.

### About Singapore 2010 Youth Olympic Games:

Singapore will be hosting the first Youth Olympic Games ( YOG ) from 14 to 26 Aug 2010. It will receive some 3,600 athletes and 800 officials from the 205 National Olympic Committees ( NOCs ), along with estimated 800 media representatives, 20,000 local and international volunteers, and more than 500,000 spectators. Young athletes – aged between 14 and 18 years – will

compete in 26 sports and take part in Culture and Education Programme.

The Singapore 2010 Youth Olympic Games will create a lasting sports, culture and education legacy for Singapore and youths from around the world, as well as enhance and elevate the sporting culture locally and regionally.

## Singapore–Philippines Joint Issue – Bridges

Date of Issue:

**28 Aug 2009**



*Stamp visuals are unavailable at the point of production for Miniature World. Full details of this issue will be announced in the next edition of Miniature World.*

Since 1969, Singapore and Philippines have enjoyed a warm bilateral relation and this year marks the 40th year of Diplomatic relations between Philippines and Singapore. To commemorate this anniversary, Singapore and Philippines will be releasing this joint stamp issue with the theme "Bridges". Chosen bridges include Henderson Waves, Alexandra Arch and Cavenagh Bridge from Singapore, and Bamban Bridge and Marcelo Fernan Bridge from the Philippines.

"Cavenagh Bridge", built in 1868, is the oldest bridge on the Singapore River. Built to commemorate the 50th Anniversary of the founding of the Crown Colony of the Straits Settlement, it was converted to a pedestrian bridge and now, with lighting added in the 1990s to accentuate its architectural features at nightfall.

"Alexandra Arch" and "Henderson Waves", both found along the Southern Ridges, were opened in May 2008. Presently Singapore's highest pedestrian bridge, Henderson Waves connects Mount Faber Park to Telok Blangah Hill Park, while the smaller bridge Alexandra Arch, connects Kent Ridge Park to Telok Blangah Hill Park via the Flora Walk.

The first mass rapid transit system came into operations in Singapore in 1987 and since then, the SMRT system had been further developed to serve more areas of Singapore.

On 28 May 2009, the first five stations, namely: Marymount, Bishan, Lorong Chuan, Serangoon and Bartley, of the 33.3km Circle Line (CCL) were added into the present SMRT railway system, enhancing convenience and connectivity

for the nation. The remaining 24 stations is targeted to open from 2010 onwards.

This set of four commemorative circular stamps presents a miniature exhibition of the Circle Line system – the Circle Line system map against the Singapore map, a new Circle Line station in the underground system, the new three car Circle Line train, and the new Circle Line Operation Control Centre situated in Kim Chuan Depot – the world's largest underground depot for trains.

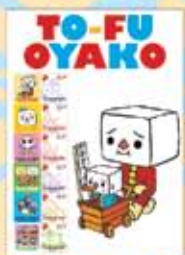

4. Stamps are supplied in mint or cancelled-to-order ( CTO ) condition, if requested. The normal Singapore Philatelic Bureau metal circular datestamp will be used on the CTO stamps.
5. All mail orders for philatelic products ( excluding Annual Collections ) are subject to a handling charge as follows:

Destination	Handling Charge
Singapore	<b>S\$0.50</b> per order
Brunei Darussalam/Malaysia	<b>S\$0.80</b> per order
Overseas	<b>S\$1.80</b> per order

*Please add S\$2.24 if you require registration service within Singapore or add \$2.20 for Brunei Darussalam/Malaysia/ Overseas. Customers who also order Annual collections need not pay the registration fee. The Singapore Philatelic Bureau will absorb all GST payable for the registration fee and handling charge.*

6. Customers who order Annual Collections are required to pay an additional handling charge as follows:

Singapore	<b>S\$6.00</b> per order
Brunei Darussalam/Malaysia	<b>S\$8.00</b> per order
Overseas ( by airmail )	<b>S\$15.00</b> per order

*All orders will be sent by registered post.*

7. Remittance for orders should include the handling charge and registration fee in addition to the value of the items ordered. Insufficient payment will be met by a reduction in the value of stamps sent.
8. Each order should be accompanied by a remittance which may be in the form of credit card, postal order, money order, cheque or bank draft made out in Singapore currency. Remittance must be payable to "Singapore Post Limited" and crossed "A/C Payee" only. Do not send cash by post.
9. Credit card payment is only available to mail order customers ie customers who place orders by post.
10. The stock list is subject to change without prior notice. Please allow about three weeks for supply of your order.
11. All claims for undelivered orders must be made within 2 months from date of issue.
